A Singstunde is a service of prayer, scripture, and singing. Literally, it translates as "hour of singing." In the 18th century, Moravians regularly held singstundes, even on a weekly basis at times. Today, we continue to use singstundes for lovefeasts and our communion services. Our singstunde this morning is for All Saints' Day Matthew 22:23-33 and Revelation 7:9-17.

Moravians believe God speaks to use through the Bible, and that we speak with God through music. I invite you to use our singing and our prayers during the singstunde to reflect on what God might be saying to you through these scriptures, or what you need to say to God at this moment in your life.
