

REGULATIONS OF THE MORAVIAN SQUARE MARKET

The purpose of the Moravian Square Market is to provide a farmers market for the community and support local ministries for the hungry.

1. Persons wanting to sell at the Moravian Square Market must submit an application at least one week before they plan to begin selling. Applications are available at the Rural Hall Moravian Church website (www.rhmc.org) or by email (pastor@rhmc.org). The fee per week to participate in the Moravian Square Market is \$5. At the end of the market season, all vendor fees will be given to a local food ministry.
2. Vendors that are selling homegrown items must have that listed on the table. If vendors are not the original producers of the items being sold, the origin of the item should be listed on the table. All vendors should also note which items are and are not organic. Baked goods must be made in an inspected kitchen. Vendors must provide a copy of their meat license prior to selling meat.
3. The Market Committee has the right to terminate a vendor's contract for any reason.
4. Vendors may authorize family members or employees to represent them at the Market as long as the family member(s) or employee(s) are listed as a proxy on the Moravian Square Market application form.
5. The Moravian Square Market will operate on the grounds of Rural Hall Moravian Church in the side gravel lot (**7939 Broad Street**) in Rural Hall. In the event of rain, the market can be moved to the Pavilion at Rural Hall Moravian Church. The Moravian Square Market will operate on **Thursdays from 2:30 pm-6:00 pm**. The selling season will begin April/May and go through the end of September/October depending on fall frost.
6. Products that can be sold at the Market include:
 - a. Vegetables
 - b. Fruits, nuts, or berries
 - c. Plants
 - d. Eggs
 - e. Cheese
 - f. Honey
 - g. Flowers
 - h. Firewood
 - i. Baked goods – all items must have ingredients listed
 - j. Meats
 - k. Crafts – all crafts must be handmade items that require skill and time to fashion

Other Requirements:

1. No animals will be sold, traded, or given away at the Moravian Square Market.
2. Each vendor is responsible for cleaning up the area around his/her space at the Market.
3. Vendors should not move their vehicles in or out of the Market during the times of operation.
4. Prices are to be posted on all items offered for sale.
5. Selling spaces are on a first come first serve basis; there are no assigned or reserved spaces.
6. Special needs requests are to be expressed in advance.
7. Vendors are required to secure tents with weights which are the vendor's responsibility to supply.
8. All participants of the Moravian Square Market are expected to be courteous, professional, and ethical in all transactions. All participants are to abide by the rules and regulations of the Moravian Square Market. This includes and is not limited to, no profanity, no tobacco products, no consumption of alcoholic beverages or any other disruptive behavior. The Moravian Square Market does reserve the right to ask a vendor to leave the premises due to any improper conduct.
